The document constitutes a clarion call and 10-point program for an organized, worldwide redoubling of resistance to the current phase of imperialism and for

the building of a global movement. Analysis and discussion of the document has influenced World Social Forum circles and, as such, it may become an important document for the upcoming WSF 2007 in Nairobi.
